WHO CAN GO?

4-H Camp is for all Clay County youth that will be entering grades 4-9 next school year or 9 to 14 years of age. You can also serve as camp counselor if you are 15-18 years of age.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO GO?

The cost for camp this year is only \$70. We have full and partial scholarships available to assist in paying the cost. We encourage all campers & families to pay as much as possible toward entire fee. **Thanks to the generous donations of several local businesses in our county for helping to lower camp cost to each camper from \$300 to \$70!!!**

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Complete the pre-registration form on the back of this brochure and return it along with your \$70 payment to the Extension Office. Mail to PO Box 421 or drop off at 69 Jameson Rd.

You will receive additional forms in the mail that must be completed prior to camp. We are limited on the number of youth who can attend—**get your application in early! Classes fill up quickly also, so get your pre-registration form in early to get the classes you want.**

WHAT ABOUT SCHOOL?

If school is still in session during our camping week according to Kentucky Statute (KRS) 159 .035, you may not be counted absent from school.
